Introduction

Introduction

Praise be to the Lord of all worlds. Prayers and peace be upon our Prophet, Muhammad, his family, and all of his companions.

This is a light book contains several types of supplications (Praise Allah the Almighty, Quranic supplications, Prophetic supplications, Prophet seeking Allah's refuge, legal supplications, and Incantations, and as well as morning and evening remembrance supplications. It also contains the etiquette of the supplication. I was very keen to include the authentic

supplications; for the Muslim to strive in praying as stated in the holy book and the Sunnah regarding the supplications that bring many good deeds. I provided every supplication in the Arabic language along with its translation in English as well as how to pronounce it. I also mentioned the verification and acceptance of the supplication at the end of the book I ask Allah the Almighty to accept this work for his sake

All Prayers and Blessings of Allah be upon him.

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Şahīh reporting in supplication and praising Allah the almighty



O Muslim, you are poor to your Lord ... rich in Him, glory is to Allah. Here are some supplications ... Prepare for them with your heart ... they are comprehensive supplication for all good deeds.

Try to memorize as much as you can. Those supplications were sufficient for Muslims to get whatever they needed. They are short in wording, wide in its meanings. You only need to present with your heart, as well as full submission to your Lord.



Etiquette of Supplication

Firstly: Faithfulness to Allah almighty. Whoever wants to perform pray (Du'a) has to ensure that he is performing with a full faithfulness to Allah almighty only, with certainty that no one other than Allah can answer his supplications, so there would be no praying nor a begging to other than Allah almighty -irrespective of being a Prophet, pious worshiper, king, or a righteous man-. Allah S.W.T says:

﴿فَادْعُواْ ٱللَّهَ مُخْلِصِينَ لَهُ ٱلَّدِينَ﴾ [غافر: ١٤]

(So invoke Allah, [being] sincere to Him in religion, although the





disbelievers dislike it) [Ghafir: 14]

Secondly: the presence of the intention that the act of supplication itself is a great act of worship that Allah almighty loves, and the rewarded will be given regardless of the answer to the supplication.

Thirdly: a full trust to the Allah Almighty and that he can answer your supplications. Also, there is a need to believe that a Muslim does not need to get close to any other creature that brings him closer to Allah almighty as such heresies lead Muslims to unlawful beseeching.

Fourthly: Allah almighty rejoices with the Muslim's







repentance no matter how much sins he has. So, beware from the following matter to not sneak into your mind that is the exclusion of the answer of your supplication and despair from Allah's mercy, rather be blissful with your repentance as Allah has rejoiced as well. Allah S.W.T says

﴿إِنَّ ٱللَّهَ يَغْفِرُ ٱلْنُّنُوبَ جَمِيعًاً ﴾ [زمر: ٥٣] (Allah forgives all sins.), and ﴿وَإِذَا سَأَلَكَ عِبَادِي عَنِّي فَإِنِّي قَرِيبٌ أُجِيبُ دَعُوَةَ ٱلدَّاعِ إِذَا دَعَانِۖ ﴾ [بقره: ١٨٦]

(And if My servants ask thee about Me - behold, I am near; I respond to the call of him who calls, whenever he calls unto Me: let





them, then, respond unto Me, and believe in Me so that they might follow the right way).

Fifthly: the food and drink of the supplicant should not be from unlawful earnings, as this is one of the obstacles to answer the supplication. The hadith of Abu Hurayrah that the Messenger of Allah, peace be upon him said:

«الرَّجُلَ يُطِيلُ السَّفَرَ أَشْعَثَ أَغْبَرَ، يَمُدُّ يَدَيْهِ إِلَى السَّمَاءِ، يَا رَبِّ، يَا رَبِّ، وَمَطْعَمُهُ حَرَامٌ، وَمَشْرَبُهُ حَرَامٌ، وَمَلْبَسُهُ حَرَامٌ، وَغُذِيَ بِالْحَرَامِ، فَأَنَى يُسْتَجَابُ لِذَلِكَ؟»:

"a man who, having journeyed far, is disheveled and dusty, and





who spreads out his hands to the sky saying "O Lord! O Lord!," while his food is haram (unlawful), his drink is haram, his clothing is haram, and he has been nourished with haram, so how can [his supplication] be answered? (Narrated by Muslim, 1015).

Sixthly: the supplicant should follow the etiquette of supplication, which are:

To supplicate while being on ablution as Muslim does for prayer.

The hadith of Abu Musa – narrated in both Sahihs- and his story with his uncle Abi Amir. In









the hadith, Abu Amir requested from Abu Musa to ask Prophet Mohammed PBUH to pray for him, and Abu Musa asked Prophet. The Prophet PBUH asked for some water and performed the ablution, and then raised his hands (towards the sky) and said,

«اللَّهُمَّ اغْفِرْ لِعُبَيْدٍ، أَبِي عَامِرٍ»

"O Allah! Forgive `Ubaid Abi 'Amir."

I saw the whiteness of his armpits (while he was raising his hands) and he added,

«اللَّهُمَّ اجْعَلْهُ يَوْمَ الْقِيَامَةِ فَوْقَ كَثِيرٍ مِنْ خَلْقِكَ، أَوْ مِنَ النَّاسِ»:

"O Allah! Upgrade him over many of Your human creatures on

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the Day of Resurrection". Narrated by al-Bukhari number (4323), and narrated by Muslim (2498).

To face the Qiblah.

To raise the hands.

It is indicated in the Hadith of Abdullah bin Abbas when he says that Umar bin Al-Khattab said: "The Prophet PBUH looked over the idolaters, and there were a thousand of them, while his Companions were three hundred and nineteen. So the Prophet of Allah faced the Qiblah, stretched forth his hands, and began beseeching his Lord: «اللَّهُمَّ أَخْبِزْلِي مَا وَعَدْتَنِي، اللَّهُمَّ آتِ مَا وَعَدْتَنِي»:

'O Allah! Fulfill what You







promised for me. [O Allah! Bring about what You promised for me]. Narrated by Muslim (1763).

To begin his supplication with praise to Allah almighty and saying the prayer of blessings upon the Prophet PBUH. The hadith of Faddaalah bin Obaid where he says that "The Messenger of Allah heard a person supplicating during prayer. He did not mention the greatness of Allah, nor did he invoke blessings on the Prophet. The Messenger of Allah said: هَذَا»: He made haste. He then called him and said either to him or to any other person:





«إِذَا صَلَّى أَحَدُكُمْ، فَلْيَبْدَأْ بِتَمْجِيدِ رَبِّهِ جَلَّ وَعَزَّ، وَالثَّنَاءِ عَلَيْهِ، ثُمَّ يُصَلِّي عَلَى النَّبِيِّ صَلَّى اللَّهُ عَلَيْهِ وَسَلَّمَ، ثُمَّ يَدْعُو بَعْدُ بِمَا شَاءَ»:

If any of you prays, he should mention the exaltation of his Lord in the beginning and praise Him; he should then invoke blessings on the Prophet; thereafter he should supplicate Allah for anything he wishes".

Therefore, if supplicant begins his supplication with praising Allah almighty, especially with the Quranic verses that praises Allah almighty and then saying the prayer of blessings upon the Prophet, he would have been closer to be answered.











The supplicant must perform supplicant with a good expectation from Allah while also being assured that the supplication will be answered, with no rush to it. Abu Huraira reported Allah's Messenger as saying:

"The supplication of the servant is granted in case he does not supplicate for sin or for severing the ties of blood, or he does not become impatient. It was said: Allah's Messenger, what does:" If he does not grow impatient" imply?









«يَقُولُ قَدْ دَعَوْتُ وَقَدْ دَعَوْتُ، فَلَمْ أَرَيَسْتَجِيبُ لِي، فَيَسْتَحْسِرُ عِنْدَ ذَلِكَ وَيَدَعُ الدُّعَاءَ»:

He said: That he should say like this: I supplicated and I supplicated but I did not find it being responded. and then he becomes frustrated and abandons supplication." Narrated by Muslim (2735)

To perform supplication with the most beautiful names of Allah with a diversify between them in a way that suits the supplication.

So, if He asks Allah a livelihood, he should call Allah with the name "Razak" while if He asks Allah a Mercy, he should call Allah with the









name "Rahman and Rahim". And if he asks Allah an appreciation, he should call Allah with the name of "Aziz", and if he asks Allah forgiveness, he should call Allah with the name of "Ghafour". And if he asks Allah a heal, he should call Allah with the name of "Shafi".

Thus, he invokes what suits his supplication. Allah SWT says

﴿وَلِلَّهِ ٱلْأَسْمَآءُ ٱلْحُسْنَىٰ فَٱدْعُوهُ بِهَامً (الأعراف: ١٨٠]

(And to Allah belong the best names, so invoke Him by them) [Al-A'raf: 180].

To repeat the words of the supplication and insist on the

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request. The hadith of Ibn Abbas in the supplication of the Prophet for his companions in Badr, where he said:

«اللَّهُمَّ أَنْجِزْ لِي مَا وَعَدْتَنِي، اللَّهُمَّ آتِ مَا وَعَدْتَنِي»:

"O Allah! Fulfill what You promised for me. [O Allah! Bring about what You promised for me] O Allah! If you destroy this band of adherents to Islam, you will not be worshiped upon the earth,' He continued beseeching his Lord with his hands stretched, facing the Qiblah until his Rida fell from his shoulders. Abu Bakr came to him, took his Rida and placed it back upon his shoulders, then embraced









him from behind and said:

'O Prophet of Allah! You have sufficiently beseeched your Lord, indeed He shall fulfill what He promised you". Narrated by Muslim (1763).

To conceal his supplication and not speak out loud. Allah SWT says

﴿ ٱدْعُواْ رَبَّكُمْ تَضَرُّعَا وَخُفْيَةً ﴾ [الأعراف: ٥٥]

(Call upon your Lord in humility and privately) [Al-A'raf: 55].

The concealment of supplication is closer to sincerity. Allah praised the supplication of Zakaria PBUH







as he did with concealment, Allah SWT says

﴿إِذْ نَادَىٰ رَبَّهُ نِدَآءً خَفِيَّا٢) [مريم: ٣]

(When he called to his Lord a private supplication) [Maryam:3]

The supplication must include praise for Allah Almighty, as Allah almighty loves when his servant praises him. This is a sort of worship too, otherwise, Allah is indispensable for his servants. It is narrated in both Sahihs from the hadith of Ibn Masoud, that Prophet PBUH says:

«وَلَا أَحَدُّ أَحَبَّ إِلَيْهِ الْمَدْحُ مِنَ اللهِ وَلِذَلِكَ مَدَحَ نَفْسَهُ»:

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"nothing is loved by Allah more than the praise of His Ownself and it is because of this that He has praised Himself".

The supplicant should search for the times of the response and perform supplication in them.

Among the places and times of the response in which the texts came: (Supplication between the call to prayer (Azaan) and the second call to prayer (Iqama) - in the last third of the night - in the hour of Friday – in the daily prayer - in the prostration - when the rain falls - the Muslim's supplication for his brother at the back of the unseen









the supplication of the father to his son - the supplication of the traveler the supplication of the oppressed).







Recompense). [Al-Fatihah: 1-3].

There are conditions and warnings that must be observed in the Ruqayya, which are:



The Ruqya must be authentic according to the Qur'an and Sunnah, far from polytheism, and forbidden things, whether in its method or its wording.



A Muslim attach himself to his Lord and trust in him and knows that Ruqya is a cause that does not affect except with the permission of Allah Almighty.









The ruqya should not be used as a matter of experience, but rather it must be believe in the effect of it, so the Raqi and the Murqi 'alyhi in the effect of the ruqya and the heal with it.



The Qur'an, all of its verses, is a healing. The Almighty said:

﴿وَنُنَزِّلُ مِنَ ٱلْقُرْءَانِ مَا هُوَ شِفَآءٌ وَرَحْمَةٌ لِلْمُؤْمِنِينَ﴾ [الإسراء:٨٢]
